The University is making the following arrangements to support gradual resumption of normal operations:

Vaccination Policy for Members Travelling on University Activities (Outbound and Inbound)

All faculty, staff and students who will be travelling outside Hong Kong on University business/activities are required to be <u>fully vaccinated</u> and meet the requirements of the <u>Vaccine Pass</u> before their departure. The same requirement must be met by those (coming from outside Hong Kong) participating in University business/activities before their arrival in Hong Kong, including inbound exchange students, visiting students, etc.

Academic Arrangements for Summer Term 2021/22

All classes in the Summer Term (June 20 - August 13, 2022) will be held in mixed-mode (i.e., students participate in a class either in-person or online) or <u>mixed-mode lite</u> while still observing the social distancing measures and other relevant guidelines. Online proctored exams/alternative assessments will be arranged for all students wherever appropriate. The following exceptions will apply:

- All Language classes and Lab classes will be held in person on campus if the situation allows.
- TPg programs may make their own arrangements.
