Outreach COVID-19 Vaccination on Campus - Additional Sinovac (科興) Vaccination Available Sunday, Mar 13, 2022, 22:03PM

Dear Members of the University,

We are pleased to inform you, Bamboos, the private medical group that provide the two recent rounds of on-campus vaccination at UST, has kindly offered additional Sinovac shots in the afternoon of 17th March 2022 (Thursday). With the Government's latest Doctor's Guide (issued 10 March) for COVID-19 vaccination under the Vaccination Subsidy Scheme (VSS), both Hong Kong residents and non-residents, including holders of "Two-way Permits" and foreign passports, aged 3 or above are now eligible to receive Sinovac vaccine through outreach vaccination. If you or your family members are eligible and interested, please use this online booking system (https://covid19-vaccine-booking.hkust.edu.hk) to make an appointment before 15th March 2022 (Tuesday) 12:00 noon.

For **persons aged 11 or above**, the following types of identity document will be accepted:

- ◇申請香港身份證收據 Acknowledgement of Application for an Identity Card

[*Non-Hong Kong Travel document includes "Two Way Permits" and foreign passports, fulfilling the following conditions:

1st and 2nd dose

Holders of Non-Hong Kong Travel Documents who are allowed to stay in Hong Kong as permitted by the law, and can complete two doses of vaccination within their limit of stay without extension.

3rd dose

Have received at least one dose of COVID-19 vaccine in Hong Kong or the remaining limit of stay in Hong Kong as stated in the landing slips or extension of stay labels issued by the Immigration Department is not less than 30 days on the date of the additional dose(s) vaccination, they can receive third dose COVID-19.

For persons under age 11, the following additional types of identity document will also be accepted

[NOTE: **For children aged 3 to 11 years with non-HK Travel Document (e.g. Foreign passports), they are eligible to receive COVID-19 vaccine if there is an Endorsement or relevant Landing Slip (if applicable) showing any one of (i) to (vii) in the Appendix A5 of

(https://www.chp.gov.hk/files/pdf/vssdg ch5 appendix a.pdf); with Visa/Reference No. and within the validity period.]

Persons under age 18 must bring a student handbook/identity document with photo 學生手冊/護照 (有相), and they must be accompanied by an adult with a consent form signed by the parent/guardian. Please note that other than the additional arrangement for Sinovac vaccination in the afternoon of 17th March, all arrangements for BioNTech vaccination on the 16th March whole day and 17th March morning, stated in the previous announcements below remain the same.
