Update on Medical Clinic Arrangements

Dear colleagues and students,

The Campus Medical Clinic has made every effort to maintain normal services and implement preventive measures to protect university members during the COVID-19 pandemic.

Given that it is the tropical cyclone and rainstorm season in Hong Kong, the temporary marquees of the Medical Clinic triage area previously set up at the outdoor carpark of LG1 will soon be removed. The triage area has now been re-located to the normal indoor entrance of the Medical Clinic at LG1 Room LG1020 - LG1024 (Lift no. 4).

While the pandemic has alleviated in Hong Kong recently, please stay vigilant and continue to observe the following preventive measures in the Medical Clinic:

- All patients are advised to put on a surgical mask when visiting the clinic and fill out a questionnaire regarding his/her symptoms and travel/contact history;
- All patients will be screened with a forehead Infrared thermometer upon entering the triage area at the indoor entrance of the clinic;
- Fever patient will be asked to wait in a negative-pressure fever room inside the clinic and given priority for fever consultation; and
- If more fever patients turn up when the fever room inside the clinic is occupied, the fever patients will be asked to wait at a separate semi outdoor area at the balcony outside the LG1 Sport Hall.

The Medical Clinic remains open at normal hours:

Monday - Friday 9 am - 12:30pm/ 1:30 pm - 4:45 pm Saturday 9 am - 11:45 am Sunday & Public Holidays Closed
